

Echo Cloud: Link Echo to Moodle using External Tool

So students can access your Echo recordings, you need to add an External Tool activity in Moodle AND click to connect the two. Instructions below.

Step-by-step guide

1. Log into Moodle
2. Select Course
3. Turn Editing On
4. Click Add an Activity or Resource
5. Select External Tool
6. Fill in Activity Name field.
7. From Preconfigured Tool drop down, choose Echo 360.
