Description

- Federal awarding agencies must include the following in each federal award:
 - General Federal Award Information
 - General Terms and Conditions
- 15 standard data elements must be provided in all Federal awards and also flowed down in Subawards.
- Research Terms and Conditions (RTC) expire 12/26/14. The FDP (Federal Demonstration Partnership) is working to secure new or existing RTC terms.
- Requires agencies to incorporate general terms and conditions.

Action Plan

- ✓ OIT will add a new, searchable attribute "FAIN" (Unique Federal Award Identification Number) field in PS Grants and Inventory modules. (Joshua Fiske)
- ✓ Closely monitor the terms and conditions of each award after December 26, 2014. (Anna Marie Dawley)

- Monitor FDP communications for updates and review impacts as information becomes available.
